

## BARRIER FREE SURFACE WALL MOUNT PULL DOWN EYEWASH INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

# PARTS LIST:

- 1 Pull Down Activation Eyewash (Item #1)
- 1 Spacer (Item #2)
- 1 Spring Clip Holder (Item #3)
- 1 Mounting Adapter (Item #4)
- 1 Pipe Nut and Washer (Item #5)
- 1. Determine mounting location for Barrier Free Surface Wall Mount Pull Down Eyewash.
- 2. The Americans with Disabilities Act requires the eyewash heads, when in the activated position, to be 36" from the floor. Measure 36" from the floor and mark that location on the wall.
- 3. The B.F. Surface Wall Mount Pull Down Eyewash has a ½" MNPT thread for the supply line. Drill a 7/8" diameter hole in the wall to accept the ½" pipe at the marked location. Also, at this time, drill a 1/8" diameter hole in the wall for the anti-vandal pin located on the eyewash valve. See mounting diagram on page 2 for hole locations.
- 4. Secure the eyewash unit to the wall by passing the pipe nipple and roll pin through the wall and secure it to the wall with the pipe washer and nut. If necessary, use the mounting adapter to securely attach the unit to the wall. See diagram on page 2.
- 5. Support the inlet supply line and attach supply line to unit.
- 6. With the unit in the off position (eyewash heads rotated up and against the wall), measure approximately 15" from the inlet and mark the location. Attach the Spacer (Item #2) and Spring Clip Holder (Item #3) to the wall at the marked location. The spacer and spring clip holder must be in line with the vertical pipe on the eyewash unit so that, when in the closed position, the pipe is held by the spring clip holder. See diagram on page 2.
- 7. Customer to supply the appropriate hardware for attaching the spacer (Item #2) and the Spring Clip Holder (Item #3) to the wall. The hole through the units accommodates a #10 diameter screw or bolt. The length of the screw or bolt should be a minimum of 2 1/16" plus the thickness of the wall. See diagram on page 2.
- 8. Test unit with normal testing procedures.
